

HOUSE RULES



Security of the yacht club is essential. All members are responsible for the security, safety, and care of the Clubhouse facilities. Members are not permitted to share the cipher lock combination number with any other persons. Sharing the web access code is also not permitted. The last person to depart the Clubhouse, regardless of the time, must ensure the Clubhouse is secure in accordance with the "Club Closing Checklist", which is posted on the bulletin board and one in the kitchen.



The Club cannot be responsible for articles of value left in the Clubhouse or elsewhere on the premises. Personal articles left on the premises will be picked up, held for thirty days, and then disposed of. Always leave the clubhouse as clean and tidy as when you entered it.



No animals are allowed inside the Clubhouse building at any time. Pets are welcome on porches, and surrounding areas. Members are to control and clean up after their pets at all times. Pets are **NOT** allowed at any CMYC sponsored events and the Board of Directors reserves the right to ban pets for bad behavior.



Smoking is not allowed in the yacht club. Smoking will be allowed on the Porch in the designated areas as long as it is not offensive to other guests.



The yacht club is for the use of all current CMYC members. NO functions may be held that limits or restricts access to the membership, if they wish to participate. In all matters, courtesy and common sense shall prevail at all times.



HOUSE RULES CONTINUED



The CMYC Board of Directors must approve all functions held in the yacht club that are not sponsored by CMYC. Outside caterers are not allowed. A \$250 deposit will be required to cover any damages to the building. The Vice Commodore will inspect the clubhouse and authorize the deposit to be returned if no damages occur. Organizers of said functions will be asked to make a donation to CMYC to help CMYC cover any maintenance cost and expense.



Guests of CMYC members must be accompanied by a CMYC member Members are responsible for the conduct of their guests. Anyone under the age of 21 must be accompanied by an adult while at the yacht club.



No Club member or guest shall sleep or campout in the yacht club.



Offensive or abusive language or behavior will not be tolerated.



Any violation of the House Rules may result in appropriate disciplinary action by the Board of Directors. Club Rules apply to all Club members and their guests.

The above rules are intended to protect the interests of CMYC.

Club House Clean Up Rules



Wipe down kitchen area, including counters and stoves if used. Clean all appliances used, and return to appropriate location. Remove all food brought in before you leave the Marina.



Pick up any loose debris lying in restrooms and empty trash cans. Brooms and mops are kept in the water heater closet by the back door.



Tie up trash bags and place in dumpster across from the Yacht Club. Put new trash bags in trash cans. Bags are kept under the sink. Black trash bags are used for large trash cans out side by the BBQ grills and deck.



Replace all furniture in correct position.



If gas grill (s) has been used, make sure gas is turned off, grill cleaned and cover in place if applicable.



All outdoor furniture should be returned to original position after use. Cushions put back in side the club house or in the deck boxes.



Turn off all lights, TV radio, fans, etc.



Close and lock fridge and back door. (Check twice)



During the winter, the heat will be lowered to 65 after use. During the summer, the air conditioning is set at 78 after use.
